




## GUIDELINES

Please ensure the following:

- 1 That you are a fully paid up member of the FBA. To qualify for the Ron Rayner Memorial Trophy for a UK First Recorded Breeding you will need to be a fully paid-up member of the FBA for at least two years and a written account, sent to the Editor, will be required for publication in *Beak & Claw*.
- 2 That the birds are bred in the year printed at the top of the report and that your report is received by the FBA Breeding Register Secretary by the end of January the following year [i.e. 2000 bred birds by 31st January 2001].
- 3 That you have clearly added your name, address and membership number on the report.
- 4 That all birds you have reported have been bred by you and have been reared to self-supporting maturity.
- 5 That you have ticked the box provided, if your breeding report has been sent to another Society.
- 6 Those for a First Breeding claim, please write the names and addresses of two witnesses below.
